



STUDENT INVOLVEMENT

AT CARROLL HIGH SCHOOL, ALL STUDENTS ARE WELCOME AND ENCOURAGED TO TAKE PART IN CLUBS THAT FIT THE INTERESTS OF EACH CHILD.

CLUBS ARE OPEN TO ALL STUDENTS WITH A 2.0 GPA OR ABOVE AND THAT COMMIT THEIR TIME TO MEETING THE MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS. ALL STUDENTS ATTEND A CLUB RUSH EVENT AT THE START OF EACH SCHOOL YEAR TO LEARN ABOUT THE DIFFERENT CLUBS AND BEGIN THEIR INVOLVEMENT JOURNEY. ONCE A MEMBER, STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO ATTEND MEETINGS, PARTICIPATE IN EVENTS, TAKE ON LEADERHSIP ROLES, AND MORE WITHIN THE CLUB.

CLUB REQUIREMENTS

EACH CLUB HAS DIFFERENT REQUIREMENTS IN ORDER FOR A STUDENT TO BE A MEMBER, INCLUDING MONTHLY MEETINGS, CLUB DUES, EVENT ATTENDANCE, APPLICATIONS, AND MORE. STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO MEET THESE IN ORDER TO RETAIN MEMBERSHIP EACH YEAR. STUDENTS ARE NOT LIMITED TO HOW MANY CLUBS THEY ARE A PART OF; HOWEVER, THEY MUST COMMIT TO MEETING THE REQUIREMENTS FOR EACH AND ARE ENCOURAGED TO MANAGE THEIR TIME WISELY. A CLUB CALENDAR IS CREATED TO ASSIST WITH STUDENTS CHOOSING CLUBS THAT DO NOT CONFLICT.

EACH CLUB HAS DUES OF AT LEAST \$30 TO JOIN.

LEADERSHIP POSITIONS

WE ENCOURAGE OUR STUDENTS TO TAKE ON LEADERSHIP ROLES WITHIN THEIR CLUBS TO LEARN MORE SKILLS AND USE THEM TO LEAD THEIR CLASSMATES. STUDENTS CANNOT HOLD THE SAME LEADERSHIP POSITION IN MULTIPLE CLUBS DURING A SCHOOL YEAR. STUDENTS CAN HOLD MULTIPLE DIFFERENT LEADERSHIP POSITIONS IN MULTIPLE CLUBS. GENERALLY, THOSE IN LEADERSHIP POSITIONS ARE REQUIRED TO ATTEND ADDITIONAL MEETINGS AND MEET ADDITIONAL GRADE AND INVOLVEMENT REQUIREMENTS.

STUDENTS INTERESTED IN STARTING A NEW CLUB ARE ENCOURAGED TO REACH OUT WITH IDEAS. NEW CLUBS MUST HAVE A FACULTY/STAFF MODERATOR AND COMPLETE THE NEW CLUB REQUEST WHICH WILL BE REVIEWED AND APPROVED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.

MODERATOR: MRS. ACOSTA



SOCIETY GPA REQUIREMENTS DIFFER WITH MOST REQUIRING OVER A 3.0 UGPA AMONG OTHER CRITERIA. HONOR SOCIETY MEMBERSHIP IS BY INVITATION ONLY BUT STUDENTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO KNOW THE CRITERIA AND DO THEIR BEST TO MEET THEM BY EXCELLING IN THEIR ACADEMICS, LEADERSHIP, SERVICE, AND MORE. UPON INVITATION TO MEMBERSHIP, STUDENTS ARE THEN REQUIRED TO COMPLETE YEARLY ACADEMIC AND INVOLVEMENT REQUIREMENTS TO MAINTAIN STATUS AND GRADUATE WITH THEIR CORD.

HONOR SOCIETY REQUIREMENTS

FOR MEMBERSHIP, STUDENTS MUST MEET CERTAIN ACADEMIC CRITERIA, HAVE NOT RECEIVED MORE THAN 5 DEMERITS EACH CALENDAR YEAR, NEVER RECEIVED A CHEATING DEMERIT, AND RECEIVE TEACHER RECOMMENDATION. BELOW ARE MORE SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS FOR EACH SOCIETY. STUDENTS CAN BE IN MORE THAN ONE SOCIETY BUT ARE STILL REQUIRED TO MEET ALL YEARLY TASKS IN ORDER TO RETAIN MEMBERSHIP.

DUES OF \$30 ARE COLLECTED ANNUALLY FOR EACH SOCIETY AND INDUCTION CEREMONY ATTENDANCE IS REQUIRED.

MODERATOR: MRS. LARROUDE




